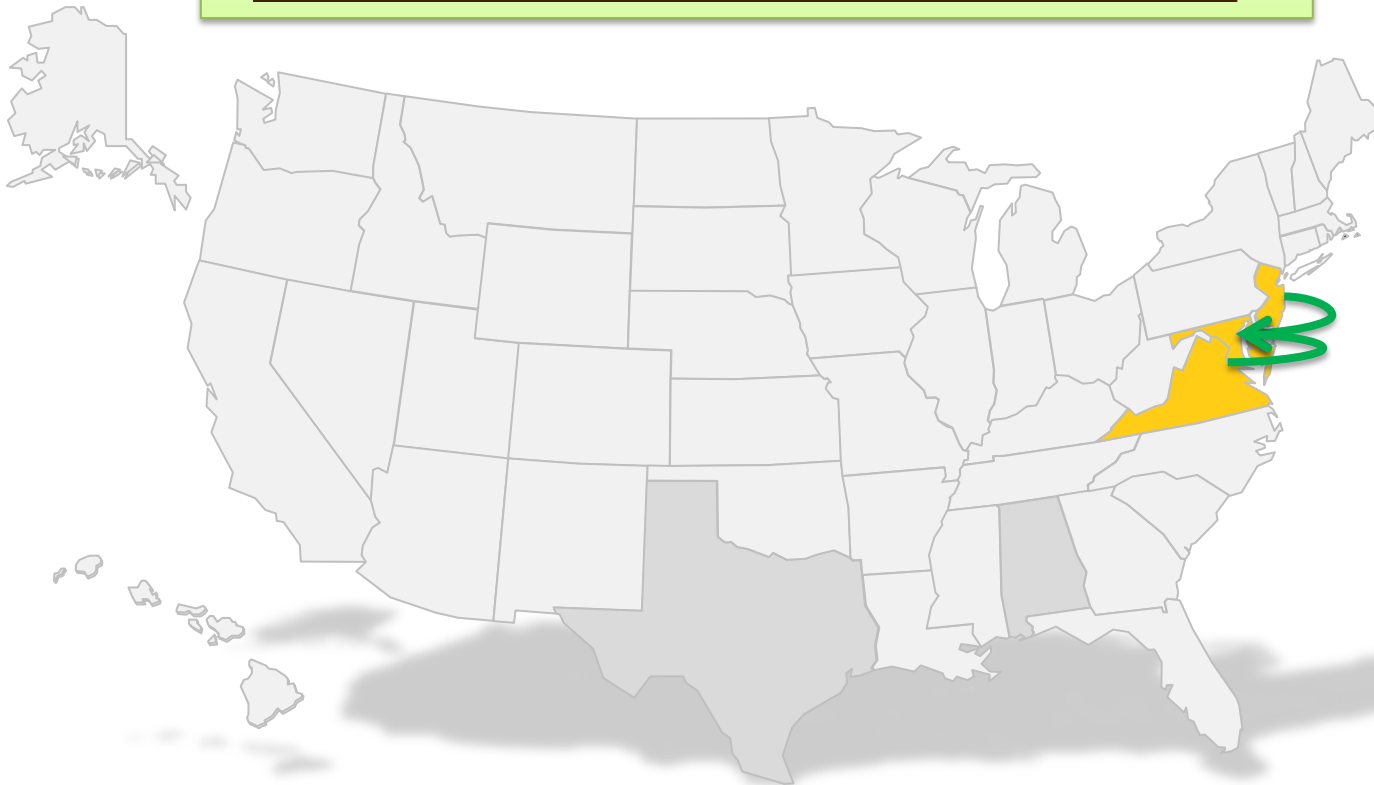
2005 Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Act

✓ *NLT 15 Sep 11: Move C4ISR Center of Excellence from Fort Monmouth, NJ & Ft Belvoir, VA to Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG), MD*

✓ *NO MISSION IMPACT & TRANSPARENT TO WARFIGHTER*

C4ISR Center of Excellence total community: transitioning 9,000+ DoD military, civilian and on site contractors

PEO C3T portion alone impacted strength is 1,600 by September 15, 2011



Number One Priority: Supporting Deployed Units

Unit Set Fielding (USF)

- Manages the planning and implementation of fielding and reset for all major tactical C4ISR Materiel Enterprise Solutions
 - Aligned with Army Force Generation (ARFORGEN) process
- Active component - 61 percent
- National Guard - 51 percent
- Reserve - 20 percent
- Multi-component - 33 percent

CENTRIXS-International Security Assistance Force

- 45 Coalition nations each used their own secure network to transmit critical information
- Coalition forces can now share data from their respective secure networks on AMN
- Migrated all appropriate mission-critical United States C4ISR systems to CX-I
- 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment - \$10 M cost avoidance

PD-CRAM Created a “Super FOB”

- Tied together more than 40 different sensors

Similar Effort: Single Integrated Air Picture (SIAP)

- Linked all radar systems operating in Iraq into one Joint service communications center
- Improved airspace deconfliction, as well as airspace sense and warning, while employing and improving Air Force digital close air support

Enhancement and Modernization

PM Battle Command Collapse Strategy

- Consolidating stand alone infrastructures and applications
- Collapsing fires, maneuver, sustainment, air defense and airspace management product lines onto a common Battle Command Workstation

Warfighter Information Network-Tactical (WIN-T) Increment 2 Milestone C (3 Feb.)

- Brings WIN-T Increment Two from the drafting table to the tactical training environment

Force XXI Battle Command Brigade-and-Below (FBCB2)/Future Iterations

- FBCB2/BFT fielded to the Marines – more than 2,100 MRAP, 1,400 M-ATV, + 5% Spares
- JCR – preparing to field in April 2011; bringing singular C2 information solution to Soldiers at the brigade-and-below level across the entire force
- BFT II – roughly 10 times faster than the existing BFT system
- JBC-P – Will include dismounted SA on Smartphones
 - Interoperability between Army and Marine Corps on JBC-P will allow them to plan Joint operations
 - Joint program, so every step we take is “lock-step” with Marine Corps
