

**Michelli, Thomas P.**  
**Executive Director of Enterprise Solutions (J-64)**

Thomas Michelli is the executive director of enterprise solutions (J-64), Defense Logistics Agency, Fort Belvoir, Va. He leads a global 3000-person information technology and data services organization responsible for delivering logistics mission success through IT solutions sustainment, service management, delivery, operations and improvement.



Michelli started his career in the military with the U.S. Army National Guard in 1984 after graduating from Franklin University and commissioning from the Ohio State University Army Reserve Officer Training Corps Program. He served in various positions in Cushman & Wakefield, Inc., a global commercial real estate firm, culminating as the Director of International IT Operations, and Director and Chief Information Officer, Europe, Middle East and Africa From 1994 to 2003. He was mobilized for two years to the United States Army's Information and Security Command, where he served as the Chief of the Regional Computer Emergency Team - Southwest Asia and then as the Director for Operations, US Army Cyber Warfare Center in April of 2003. Michelli worked in the role of the chief technology officer for General Dynamics Information Technology, Army Business Unit from 2005 to 2006. In 2006, he transitioned to government service as the chief, information operations for the Defense Threat Reduction Agency. In March 2009, he began his service with DLA as the supervisor, information systems, Information Operations Directorate, and the J-6 staff director for Information Assurance. In September 2009, the DLA Director detailed Michelli to stand up and lead the DLA Intelligence Directorate, where he served as the director until March 2010.

Throughout Michelli's long career in information operations, he has succeeded in designing, implementing and maintaining enterprise systems that advance organizational strategy and vision and enabling mission success and competitive advantage.

Michelli holds the rank of colonel in the United States Army Reserve where he serves as the director for Future Operations, Joint Public Affairs Support Element for the U.S. Joint Forces Command.

His professional and civilian education includes a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with a major in Finance from Franklin University, Columbus, Ohio; a Master of Science Degree in Computer Information Systems from St. Mary's University, San Antonio, Texas; post-baccalaureate certificate in Information Systems from Virginia Commonwealth University, Richmond, Va.; Army Officer Intermediate Level Education from the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College; and Information Technology Certified Acquisition Professional Level III certification from the Defense Acquisition University. He is also certified as a computer information systems security professional and as a project management professional.

Michelli's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal, and the Army Commendation Medal with four oak leaf clusters.
